




HOW TO SEARCH IN ONLINE DATABASES



CityU library's website http://library.cityu.edu/ offers a lot of various high quality online resources in an easy-to-use format with free access for BSBA and MBA students and instructors. For effective searching it is important to use key words, and specify your requirements in "advanced search" as much as possible. There are more possibilities how to search in CityU Online Databases.

1. COURSE RESOURCES




- The best and easiest way how to search online sources is according to a specific course.
- Click on "Find My Required Course Resources"
- Here is a list with course codes and course numbers according to which you can easily find a specific course you are attending and for which you need to find some sources for essays, presentations etc.

The CityU Library and Learning Resource Center's collection is 98% online!


From the search box, search multiple online databases, e-books, and other resources.

You can also choose "Advanced Search" if you want to specify your requirements. Use the many limiters, such as **Get It Now (for full-text only)**, publication date, subject area, and more to find what you need.




Example of research results:

On tho top you can see recommended CU online databases to use.

There are 3,639,375 results. You can specify them on the right side according your requirements. When there is written <u>Online</u> it means that this specific article or book is available in a full text and you can have it immediately. Click on the link <u>Get it now.</u> Either you get directly to the full text or you will get the link for specific database.




SEARCHING CITYU DATABASES



Respond will be delivered directly to you CityU Email Address which is created automatically for every student of CityU. Every student has this school email from the beginning of studying at City University of Seattle. Email is in format: name.surname@vsm-student.sk. When you do not use this email address, you can easily transfer school emails to your personal email address. It can be easily done in "Settings" of CityU email. If article is available, it will be sent to your email till 2 or 5 days or sooner. If required article is not available, you will be informed as well.
