- will be able to critically analyze various business management problems, propose partial solutions and manage the process of their introduction and subsequent evaluation,

- will be able to prepare and present professional presentations either in Slovak or English.

The professional skills, abilities and competences that the graduate acquires during his studies enable him to be employed on the domestic and international labor market. The graduate will reach level 6 of the Slovak qualification framework, which also corresponds to the possibilities of its application within the professions identified below.

The study program is also conducted in English, as the study program is based on the study program of the partner school City University of Seattle and allows the use of resources used in the BSBA program of the City University of Seattle. The aim of the study program in English is to provide professional skills, abilities and competences that the graduate will use when applying on the domestic and international labor market, and at the same time to develop international cooperation with partner universities towards double diplomas. Its purpose is to provide an attractive education for foreign students, the involvement of foreign professors in teaching, and thereby support the internationalization of VŠM.

4. Structure and content of the study programme

The study plan of the study program was created in accordance with the rules for creating study plans established in the VŠM Study Regulations.

Representatives of employers collaborated on the creation of the study plan, and international compatibility and comparability with City University of Seattle study programs was also taken into account, based on their experience with employers and graduates.

The study plan determines the time and content sequence of subjects, assigned educational activities (lecture, exercise, seminar, consultations, etc.) and forms of evaluation of study results. Each subject is completed in an adequate form according to the nature of the subject. Specific criteria and forms of evaluation of study results are published in the information sheets of individual subjects.

- For each subject within the recommended study plan, the educational activities used (lecture, seminar) are specified, including their hourly subsidy. The information is contained in the information sheets of individual subjects.

The teaching of individual subjects is based on the connection of theoretical and practical skills, which enables the improvement of expertise and the development of practical skills and competencies of students. In this way, the students themselves contribute to the creation and use of individual

assignments and tasks, which increases their interest in the subject matter or solved problems. Teachers use various activities to achieve the learning goals listed in the information sheets of individual subjects. For example:

- lectures.
- Case studies,
- presentations,
- seminars,
- discussions,
- team work,
- work on project, etc.,
- CAPSIM business simulation in the study programs in the English language

Of course, there is also space and time for consultations, whether individual or group.

Methods, curricula, student workload are listed in the information sheets of individual subjects.

The subject teachers are listed in the information sheets.

The name list of persons teaching and responsible for individual subjects of the study program is provided in a separate document - Persons teaching and responsible for the study program.

When studying each subject, students have the option of choosing between face-to-face and distance learning methods (online form). This gives them the opportunity to choose the optimal combination of teaching methods within the study. Some subjects can be completed face-to-face, other subjects are completed online, in accordance with their individual needs.

In addition, the student chooses electives from a number of options.

The diversity of students and their needs is thus fully respected in teaching. The student can choose the order of subjects in the year and trimester in which he wants to complete the subject, with the restriction that registration for some subjects is conditional on the successful completion of some other subjects. If not enough students register for a course (face-to-face or online), the course is canceled and the registered student must find another way to study the course, or register for it in the next trimester when the course is offered. This also applies if the student does not meet the criteria for successfully completing the subject.

If the student has previous education or experience in one of the subjects of the study plan, he can apply for a proficiency test in the given subject without the need to complete the subject and thus receive credits for education obtained outside VŠM, or knowledge acquired through practice. A student can thus obtain a maximum of 15 credits within the bachelor's program. This enables the flexibility of learning trajectories and the achievement of educational outcomes.

In addition, the study program also enables appropriate education outside the university in domestic or foreign institutions, through mobility support (especially Erasmus +). The results of this education are recognized by the university and detailed in the VŠM Study Regulations.

	VŠM students are required to study continuously throughout the trimester, while their final grade is composed of several partial assessments, which are set in the syllabus of each subject and students are familiarized with them at the beginning of the trimester. The syllabi contain not only the percentage shares of the student's activities on the final grade, but also a detailed breakdown of the assessment of the given activity (what the activity must contain and what is the share of this activity in the grade for the activity). The required activities are:

The final thesis is also a mandatory part of the study. The procedure for preparing, checking originality, registering, storing and making theses available is regulated by a separate document accessible to students and supervisors.

Conditions for recognition of studies or a part of studies.

A student may have credits recognized he/she obtained by studying at another accredited college/university in the Slovak Republic or abroad during the last 5 years or in another study program at VŠM. A maximum of 135 credits can be recognized in the bachelor's degree. It is required that the student has completed at least 9 subjects from the last two years of study at VŠM.

The topics of final theses of the study programme

The list of FT topics is attached to the study program accreditation application.

Rules for the assignment, processing, opposition, defense and evaluation of final theses in the study programme

By preparing the final thesis, the student proves that he/she has acquired theoretical knowledge and knowledge from the completed subjects of the study plan of the study program, knows how to work with literature and knows how to apply the acquired knowledge in solving mostly specific practical tasks/topics. Through the processing and defense of the final thesis, the student is mainly led to independence, creativity, submission of own proposals for identifying and solving problems and the ability to defend their solutions and proposals.

Each student chooses a final thesis topic from the official list of final thesis topics published by individual supervisors (academic staff of the school). The number of topics usually exceeds the number of students who have to choose topics by several times. The topics of final papers are always updated at the beginning of each trimester (students have the opportunity to start writing papers in October, January and April). At the beginning of the first trimester of thesis writing, students have a detailed instruction on writing the thesis, on the course of the defense of the final thesis and on the course of the essays. The instruction is carried out by the so-called senior coordinator for state exams. In addition, students will also receive instruction in written form.

At the end of the first trimester, the student submits the final project in written form to the supervisor of his final thesis, based on which the

supervisor gives approval/disagreement to the student's progress to the next trimester. Only after this consent, confirmed by the supervisor's signature, can the student register for the next trimester. After this next trimester, the student submits the final work according to the prescribed requirements in the syllabus to the study department, for originality control both by the control system at the school and by the control system through the CRZP.

The supervisor's approval is again required to submit the thesis, but he does not only grade the final thesis, but prepares the thesis supervisor's opinion for the final thesis and the student. The protocol on the control of originality is a condition for admitting the student to the state exam and a condition for admission to the defense of the final thesis is, except in cases according to § 63 par. 11, the student's written consent to publishing and making the final thesis available to the public according to § 63 par. 9 for the period of its storage according to § 63 par. 7 without entitlement to remuneration. In the last trimester, the thesis is handed over to the opponent of the final thesis for evaluation. Opponents are assigned to individual final theses by the school. The opponent grades the final work with A, B, C, D, E, FX. In addition, in this trimester, students complete the preparation of the defense of the final thesis and the necessary consultations for the preparation of the defense with the thesis supervisor. The individual political trimesters do not have to follow immediately one after the other, but the student can take a trimester break between trimesters. This ensures the flexibility of the trajectory of the study plan with regard to the needs of the student.

The state exam consists of the defense of the final thesis (the final thesis and its defense form one subject, which is classified by the examination committee on the day of the state exam with grades A, B, C, D, E or FX)

List and characteristics of the study programme classrooms and their technical equipment

Characteristics of the study programme information management

VŠM has space in a building at Panónská cesta 17 in Petržalka. The educational and administrative premises of the school for the purpose of securing accredited study programs are located on a total of 2 floors. The premises are soundproofed and meet the hygienic requirements of school buildings. In the building, the school has a total of 5 furnished classrooms and 2 computer laboratories, a library area, near which there is also a relaxation zone for students, offices for administration and teachers.

The material and technical provision of studies at VŠM is adequate and corresponds to the requirements set for the provision of accredited university studies. In accordance with the long-term strategy of the school and the long-term intention of VŠM, the equipment is permanently improved and renewed. The school has a library, study rooms with Internet access, sufficient computing equipment with wireless Internet access, including online access to databases of scientific and professional literature.

VŠM has a contract with Microsoft. Its multi-licensing program Campus 3 allows you to use the latest products that are included in this license agreement. These are the operating systems of workstations, servers, the Exchange mail system and application software (MS Office, etc.)

Students have personal mailboxes created in the Office 365 cloud system. At the same time, it offers the possibility of installing complete MS OFFICE packages on up to 5 institutions, which is very practical. Since MS OFFICE products are also widely used in commercial industries/companies, especially students have a good foundation for their professional growth, as they use these products throughout their studies.

For the needs of online study, the LMS system MOODLE and MS Teams are used for studies in Slovak and BrightSpace for studies in English. One audio/video classroom is equipped with a television and editing studio where there are modern professional tools for the creation of audiovisual content serving ensuring quality online study. The studio consists of two professional HD cameras, studio sound, lighting, director's desk and workstations. Audiovisual materials that are created here either by teachers or students are post-production processed in a video editing room and then distributed to students via Internet channels.

The School of Management is involved in the SANET academic data network. Within the premises of our university, a WIFI network is available for students, as well as for academic staff and administration.

Access to study literature according to Course information sheets, access to information databases and other information sources

The library fund exceeded 20,000 titles in 2020-2021. Information about its content is in a database accessible via the Internet. Altogether, there are more than 27,000 library units. The library of the University of Management with its exceptional collection of English professional literature has become known to the professional public, which is also reflected in the increase in requests for the interlibrary loan service from other libraries.

Most of the official titles that students of subjects in English must acquire for their studies are foreign, financially demanding textbooks, the availability of which is limited on the Slovak market. That is why VŠM introduced the "Academic Resource Fee System", thanks to which all students have access to a complete textbook service at affordable prices. This system reduces students' costs for

study, by relieving them of the need to purchase financially demanding foreign literature for each subject.

	Learning materials for subjects in Slovak Since the beginning of the 2014/2015 academic year, the school has introduced a new form of providing textbooks. On the basis of a 3-month payment, the student gets an access to the entire portfolio of textbooks in electronic form, i.e. not only to the textbooks of the subjects he registered. The service is provided by the company Wolters Kluwer, s.r.o., while access is possible from any location in online/offline mode after installing the Smarteca application on devices such as a computer or tablet or on the web www.smarteca.sk. Another effective resource is the offer of the Center for Scientific and Technical Information through the National Science Library and their electronic information resources.
